14 THAI FIRMS NAMED IN DJSI

The Stock Exchange of Thailand has announced that 14 Thai listed companies have been included in the Dow Jones Sustainability Indices (DJSI), one of the most highly regarded global sustainability indices.

This reflects Thai listed firms' potential and quality towards global standards and underlines the SET's strategic plan to promote the sustainability of the capital market, the bourse said.

This list consists of one newcomer, Kasikornbank (KBANK), in addition to the 13 Thai firms already recognised by the DJSI. Significantly, Thai Oil (TOP) was ranked the highest, for the second consecutive year, among the 159 global firms in the Energy Industry Group.

Five of the 14 selected firms, namely KBANK, PTT, PTT Exploration and Production (PTTEP), PTT Global Chemical (PTTGC) and Siam Cement (SCC), have been elected to the 2016 Dow Jones Sustainability World Index.

Advanced Info Service (ADVANC), Airports of Thailand (AOT), BANPU, Charoen Pokphand Foods (CPF), Central Pattana (CPN), IRPC, KBANK, Minor International (MINT), PTT, PTTEP, PTTGC, SCC, TOP and Thai Union Group (TU) have been chosen to be in the Dow Jones Sustainability Emerging Markets Index.
